- Needed: 24 Youth from Asian Countries (including the Republic of Korea)
- Eligibility
  - Undergraduate or graduate students between 19-29 years of age from Korea or other Asian countries who are currently residing in Korea
    - ◆ Students currently on a leave of absence may also apply
    - ◆ Applicants from Asian countries other than the ROK are required to have a D-2 Visa (Please refer to the attachment named "List of Countries/ Regions")
  - Being able to present fluently in English
  - Having an interest in international affairs
- Activities: Presenting solutions to the Asia-related issue as a team
- Documents: Application, certificate of enrollment, D-2 Visa (only applicable to international students)

- Selection Criteria: Willingness to participate, level of interest, personal capacities, etc.
